Minutes of the
Special Council Meeting
Held January 29, 2019

The special meeting of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor Richard P. Gard at 5:30 p.m. City Council Members present were Karla Borders, Tim Hancock, Mike Bailey, Rebecca Schatza and Kyle Larson. Council Member Bailey led the pledge of allegiance and Mayor Gard conducted the invocation.

Roll call was conducted. Council Member Hancock moved, seconded by Council Member Bailey to excuse Council Member(s) Sean Peterson from tonight's meeting. Motion passed unanimously. Mayor Gard declared a quorum of the Council.

Larsen Living Trust – City Clerk/Human Resource Director Kristin Watson reported on a retail liquor license transfer of ownership and transfer of location request submitted to the City Clerk's office from Ricci D. Larsen Living Trust. This license is currently owned by The Burleson Group, LLC d/b/a Third Base Sports Bar. Council Member Bailey moved, seconded by Council Member Larson to open the public hearing. Motion passed unanimously. Lindsey Cox, trustee of the Ricci D. Larsen Living Trust, was present to answer any questions. Council Member Hancock moved, seconded by Council Member Bailey to close the public hearing. Motion passed unanimously. Council Member Hancock moved, seconded by Council Member Bailey to approve the liquor license transfer of ownership and transfer of location from The Burleson Group, LLC d/b/a Third Base Sports Bar to Ricci D. Larsen Living Trust. Motion passed unanimously.
