

ENROLLED ORDINANCE NO. 17-019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9 “PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS AND WELFARE”, REVISING CHAPTER 9.08 “OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC PEACE AND DECENCY”, SECTION 9.08.200 “PUBLIC INTOXICATION”; OF THE RIVERTON MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIVERTON, FREMONT COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1.

Title 9, Chapter 9.08, Section(s) 9.08.200 is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.08.200 Public Intoxication

- A. No person shall be in a public place, street, or sidewalk, or in any vehicle parked on a public place, street, or sidewalk while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage or a drug or any combination of any alcoholic beverage and drug to a degree that he or she is unable to care for his or her own safety.
- B. ~~Violators shall be arrested.~~ *Violations of this section shall be punishable by a fine of up to \$750.00 and/or incarceration for up to 6 months.*

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from its adoption and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Riverton.
