

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 18-002

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO ALL “CITY ENGINEER” REFERENCES THROUGHOUT THE RIVERTON MUNICIPAL CODE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIVERTON, FREMONT COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1. Change all references of “city engineer” to “Community Development Director” in titles: 15 Buildings and Construction; 17 Zoning; and 18 Airport Zoning; and in chapters: 10.16 Stopping, standing and parking generally; and in sections: 1.04.030 Annexation; 12.16.010 Permit; 12.16.030 Street cut repairs; 12.16.040 Street cut repairs – Notice to ~~City Engineer~~ *Community Development Director*; 16.16.020 Streets, alleys and easements.

Section 2. Change all references of “city engineer” to “Public Works Director” in titles: 13 Public Services; and in chapters: 12.04 Streets and sidewalks generally; and in sections: 10.04.070 Authority to install; 12.16.020 Replacement or Repair of Surface by City.

Section 3. Change all references of “city engineer” to “Community Development Director or his or her designee” in chapter: 12.08 Sidewalk, Driveway, Curb & Gutter Construction and Repair.

Section 4. Change all references of “city engineer” to “Public Works Director or his or her designee” in section: 10.04.080 Marking of bus stops, taxi stands, etc. – Defacing signs;

Section 5. Section 2.24.020 Duties generally. is hereby amended to read as follows:

The public works director shall supervise the maintenance and operation of the city water system, irrigation system, streets and alleys, city landfill, city sewer system, city sanitation operation and all other operations and maintenance functions of the city. ~~which are not specifically assigned to the city engineer.~~ (Ord. 1113 § 1, 1998)

Section 6. The definition reference of “city engineer” in Section 13.20.010 Definition of terms. is hereby repealed.

Section 7. Section 13.20.320 Entry and use of easements. is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~The city engineer and other d~~ Duly authorized employees of the city bearing proper credentials and identification shall be permitted to enter all private properties through which the city holds a duly negotiated easement for the purposes of, but not limited to inspection, observation, measurement, sampling, repair and maintenance of any portion of the wastewater facilities lying within such easement. All entry and subsequent work, if any, on such easement, shall be done in full accordance with the terms of the duly negotiated easement pertaining to the private property involved. (Prior code § 21-31)

Section 8. Section 13.24.020 Designation and dedication. is hereby amended to read as follows:

The aviation field as laid down and described on the plat ~~on file in the office of the city engineer~~ *recorded with the Fremont County Clerk* is designated as the Riverton Municipal Airport dedicated to the use of the public for the purposes for which it is adopted. (Prior code § 14-2)

Section 9. Section 16.16.080(B)(2)(a) Drainage and storm sewers. is hereby amended to read as follows:

a. Where a public storm sewer is accessible, the applicant shall install storm sewer facilities or, if no outlets are within a reasonable distance, adequate provision shall be made for the disposal of stormwaters, subject to the specifications of the ~~city engineer~~ *City of Riverton*. However, in

subdivisions containing lots less than fifteen thousand (15,000) square feet in area and in business and industrial districts, underground or surface storm sewer systems shall be constructed throughout the subdivisions and be conducted to an approved out-fall.

Section 10. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 11. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Riverton.
