

**ENROLLED ORDINANCE NO. 18-009**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 17 “ZONING”, TO REVISE CHAPTER 17.16 “GENERAL REQUIREMENTS”, SECTION 17.16.050 “FENCES, HEDGES, TREES AND WALLS”, OF THE RIVERTON MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIVERTON, FREMONT COUNTY, WYOMING:**

**Section 1.**

**Title 17, Chapter 17.16, Section(s) 17.16.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:**

~~Fences, hedges, trees, and walls shall be considered as permitted accessory uses except that:~~

~~A. No fence, hedge, tree, or wall shall be permitted which obstructs vision to an intersecting street, or right of way, or which is a potential hazard to vehicular or pedestrian traffic.~~

~~B. A fence, hedge, or wall shall not exceed forty eight (48) inches in height, as measured from the top of curb, when said fence, hedge, or wall is located on the property line that parallels a street or right of way with exception to an alley. Side yard fences shall taper from the forty eight (48) inches height to full height allowed within a minimum of eight horizontal feet from the front property line.~~

~~C. A fence or wall shall not exceed seven feet in height unless a civil or professional engineer has stamped its design.~~

~~D. No fence, hedge, tree, or wall shall be constructed or planted in a right of way without written consent from the public works department.~~

~~E. The building official, or their designee, may order any fence, hedge, tree, or wall that does not comply with this section, to be removed or trimmed, not later than thirty (30) days after date of such order, at the expense of the owner, lessee, or occupant pursuant to the provisions of Section 17.16.060.~~

*The requirements entitled “CITY OF RIVERTON FENCING REQUIREMENTS”, in this section herein and hereafter shall be reviewed by the City Council and may be adjusted at such time by resolution of the City Council following public notice and hearing on such change. Effective changes will be published on the city website.*

**Section 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect from its adoption and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Riverton.
