Minutes of the

Work Session

Held February 27, 2018

7:00 PM

A Work Session of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor John L. Baker at 7:00 p.m. in the Urbigkit Conference Room, Riverton City Hall. City Council Members present were Lance Goede, Tim Hancock, Mike Bailey, Kyle Larson, Sean Peterson, and Holly Jibben (telephonically). Council Member Goede led the Pledge of Allegiance. Invocation was conducted by Council Member Hancock.

Roll call was conducted. Mayor Baker declared a quorum of the council.

City Staff present were City Administrator Tony Tolstedt, City Clerk/Human Resource Director Kristin Watson, Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield, Chief of Police Eric Murphy, Interim Community Development Director Dave Paskett, and Finance Director Mia Harris.

Council Member Peterson moved, seconded by Council Member Goede for the approval of the agenda as presented.

Goal Setting Session – City Administrator Tony Tolstedt facilitated the work session by reviewing the goals that were discussed and presented by Council Members at the previous work session held on February 13, 2018. Council and Staff further discussed the proposed objectives to ensure the goals are measurable and consistent. The goals will be presented for adoption at a regular meeting of the city council. No action was taken.

Council Member Larsen voiced his concerns about the School District's use of City roads, more specifically Sunset Ave. The roads are being damaged by the school buses in that area. Council Member Larsen also stated that the utility system in the area is not adequate to serve such a large facility, such as a new school that was not anticipated. The discussion between Council Members lead to the importance of contacting the local legislators regarding House Bills 13 & 14 which address extraterritorial jurisdiction and the removal of approval authority by cities and towns. No action was taken.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Hancock, moved, seconded by Council Member Peterson to adjourn the meeting at 8:42 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
