

**RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL**

Minutes of the  
Work Session  
Held March 13, 2018  
7:00 PM

A Work Session of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor John L. Baker at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Riverton City Hall. City Council Members present were Lance Goede, Tim Hancock, Mike Bailey, Kyle Larson, Sean Peterson, and Holly Jibben (telephonically). Council Member Bailey led the Pledge of Allegiance. Invocation was conducted by Council Member Larson.

Roll call was conducted. Mayor Baker declared a quorum of the council.

City Staff present were City Administrator Tony Tosltedt, City Clerk/Human Resource Director Kristin Watson, Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield, Chief of Police Eric Murphy, Finance Director Mia Harris, and Deputy City Clerk/Administrative Assistant Megan Sims.

Council Member Hancock moved, seconded by Council Member Peterson for the approval of the agenda with the addition of an executive session after agenda item number 8. Motion passed unanimously.

**Idea, Inc Presentation: Economic Development** - City Administrator Tony Tosltedt introduced Kevin Kershisnik with Idea, Inc. Mr. Kershisnik also introduced additional members of IDEA, Inc: Alan Moore, Lee Heermann, Lynn McAuliffe, George Piplica, and John Gunnerson. The Council was briefed on future economic development plans as well as strategies IDEA, Inc provides local business to assist in successes for each business. Mr. Kershisnik also discussed the importance of economic development in regards to developing a new master plan. No action was taken.
