Minutes of the
Council Work Session
Held March 8, 2016
7:00 PM

A Work Session of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor John L. Baker at 7:00p.m. City Council Members present were Mike Bailey (telephonically), Martin Cannan, Lee Martinez, Kyle Larson, and Holly Jibben. Council Member Cannan led the Pledge of Allegiance. Invocation was conducted by Mayor Baker.

Roll call was conducted. Mayor Baker declared a quorum of the Council. Council Member Larson moved, seconded by Council Member Martinez to excuse Council Member Peterson from tonight's meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

City Staff present were City Administrator Steven Weaver, City Clerk/Director of Administrative Services Courtney V. Bohlender, City Secretary Megan Sims, Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield, Police Chief Mike Broadhead, and Community Development Director Sandy Luers.

Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council Member Larson to approve the agenda as written. Motion passed unanimously.

Senior Center Endowment Discussion – Council Member Holly Jibben informed the Council of the current happenings with the Senior Center Endowment Board Meetings. Ms. Jibben also discussed the past practices of the endowment board and the old agreement versus the new agreement that has been presented to them. Council consensus was to support the new agreement and the checks/balances she has put in place for payment from Endowment funds.

Ordinance Proposal for Underage Smoking – Chief of Police Mike Broadhead updated the council on staff's recommendation for underage smoking fines. It is the consensus of the council to have city staff draft a proposed ordinance pursuant to fines and use of vapor devices for underage smoking.

Fourteen (14) Principles of Ethical Conduct Discussion – Mayor Baker mentioned the fourteen (14) principles of ethical conduct that was handed out at WAM.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Larson, moved, seconded by Council Member Martinez to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
