

RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL

Minutes of the
Special Meeting
Held April 10, 2018
7:00 PM

A Special Meeting of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor John L. Baker at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Riverton City Hall. City Council Members present were Lance Goede, Tim Hancock, Mike Bailey, Kyle Larson, and Sean Peterson. Council Member Goede led the Pledge of Allegiance. Invocation was conducted by Council Member Bailey.

Roll call was conducted. Council Member Goede moved, seconded by Council Member Hancock to excuse Council Member Holly Jibben from tonight's meeting. Motion passed unanimously. Mayor Baker declared a quorum of the council.

Council Member Peterson moved, seconded by Council Member Goede for the approval of the agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Eastern Shoshone Planned Unit Development (PUD) - City Administrator Tony Tosltedt presented Resolution No. 1363: E Shoshone Business Park PUD Guidelines Agreement, Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) re: Drainage Development, Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity Agreement, and Special Improvement District Agreement to the Council. Mayor Baker introduced Eastern Shoshone Tribe Chairman and Members Clint Wagon, Nick Harris, Leslie Shakespeare, Developer Steve Wilson, and Attorney Kim Craven. Mr. Wagon and Mr. Wilson approached the Council in regards to the E Shoshone PUD.

Council Member Bailey moved, seconded by Council Member Goede to approve Resolution No. 1363. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Peterson moved, seconded by Council Member Bailey to approve the MOU for drainage development. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Hancock moved, seconded by Council Member Bailey to approve the Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity Agreement. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Bailey moved, seconded by Council Member Hancock to approve the Special Improvement District Agreement. Motion passed unanimously.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Hancock, moved, seconded by Council Member Peterson to adjourn the meeting at 7:27 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
