Minutes of the
Council Work Session
Held April 14, 2015
7:00 PM

A Work Session of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor John L. Baker at 7:00p.m. City Council Members present were Mike Bailey, Martin Cannan, Jonathan Faubion, Lee Martinez, Kyle Larson and Holly Jibben. Council Member Cannan led the Pledge of Allegiance and Council Member Larson lead the Invocation.

City Staff present were City Administrator Steven Weaver, City Clerk/Administrative Services Director Courtney V. Bohlender, City Secretary Megan Sims, Chief of Police Mike Broadhead and Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield.

Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council Member Larson to approve the agenda as written. Motion passed unanimously.

Bareknuckle Boxing/Fighting By Arrangement Discussion – Chief of Police Mike Broadhead presented an informational report regarding Bareknuckle Boxing or Fights by Arrangement. Also in attendance was City Attorney Rick Sollars who informed the Council of the research he had conducted regarding this issue. Tim Lueckenhoff, President of the Association of Boxing Commissions, joined the meeting via telephone and offered the council information pursuant to federal law and boxing. It was the consensus of the council to have staff draft an ordinance based on the information received and mirroring federal law.

Presentation by Wyoming Liquor Division – Tom Montoya and Kelly Hunt of the Wyoming Liquor Division presented an informational program on the daily operations, licenses and regulation regarding liquor laws. License types were described in depth per license: full retail, restaurant, bar & grill, resort, and limited retail (clubs). To close out the presentation, Mr. Hunt reported on the regulations for a dispensing room.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Larson, moved, seconded by Council Member Martinez to adjourn the meeting at 8:55 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
