Minutes of the
Council Work Session
Held June 14, 2016
7:00 PM

A Work Session of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor John L. Baker at 7:00p.m. City Council Members present were Mike Bailey, Martin Cannan, Lee Martinez, Kyle Larson, Sean Peterson and Holly Jibben. Council Member Jibben led the Pledge of Allegiance. Invocation was conducted by Mayor Baker.

Roll call was conducted. Mayor Baker declared a quorum of the Council.

City Staff present were City Administrator Steven Weaver, Finance Director Gloria Hardman, City Secretary Megan Sims, Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield, Police Chief Mike Broadhead, and Community Development Director Sandy Luers.

Council Member Peterson moved, seconded by Council Member Larson to approve the agenda with the addition of pari-mutuel betting presentation after item #8. Motion passed unanimously.

Ombudsman Presentation: Jane Juve – Chief of Police Mike Broadhead introduced Ombudsman Jane Juve to the council. Ms. Juve provided the council with information in regards to the Community Relations Ombudsman and the importance of the Civil Rights Act. A Free Fair Housing Training will be held on Tuesday, July 12, 2016.

Wind River Job Corp Presentation: Julie Gassner – Julie Gassner, Center Director of Wind River Job Corps, gave a presentation of an overview of the past year at Wind River Job Corps. Ms. Gassner informed the council of the economic impact the center has on the City of Riverton, the current students enrolled at the Job Corps, the community service projects taking place, and upcoming events, respectively.

Pari-Mutuel Betting Presentation – Eugene Joyce, President of Wyoming Horse Racing, LLC, presented the council with an overview of Pari-Mutuel betting in Wyoming. Mr. Joyce requested support of the City of Riverton to allow Pari-Mutuel Betting/Wagering to occur in Riverton. No action was taken.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Larson, moved, seconded by Council Member Peterson to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
