

RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL

Minutes of the
Regular Council Meeting
Held July 19, 2016
7:00 PM

The regular meeting of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor John L. Baker at 7:00 p.m. City Council Members present were Martin Cannan, Lee Martinez, Sean Peterson and Holly Jibben. Council Member Cannan led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mayor Baker conducted the invocation.

Roll call was conducted. Mayor Baker declared a quorum of the Council. Council Member Peterson moved, seconded by Council Member Jibben to excuse Council Member Mike Bailey and Council Member Kyle Larson from tonight's meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

City Staff present: City Administrator Steven M. Weaver, Finance Director/Interim City Clerk Gloria A. Hardman, Public Works Director Kyle J. Butterfield, Community Development Director Sandy Luers, Chief of Police Mike Broadhead, and City Secretary Megan Sims.

Approval of the Agenda – Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council Member Peterson to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Communication from the Floor/Response to Citizen's Comments – Jason Hawk with Bar 10 approached the council requesting an Open Container Permit Application from Bar 10 on July 21, 2016 for Alive @ 5 in the street in front of Bar 10 from 5:00 pm – 9:00 pm. Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council member Jibben to approve the Open Container Permit Application from Bar 10. Motion passed with Council Member Peterson, Council Member Jibben and Mayor Baker voting aye. Council Member Cannan and Council Member Martinez voted nay. Eric Carr, Chairman of the Riverton Rendezvous Committee, thanked the community and the City of Riverton for their support on a successful Riverton Rendezvous Balloon Rally.

Consent Agenda – Finance Director/Interim City Clerk Gloria A. Hardman read the consent agenda items by title only: Approval of the Minutes – July 5, 2016 Regular Council Meeting; Approval of the Minutes – July 19, 2016 Finance Committee Meeting; Approval of the Finance Committee Recommendations – July 19, 2016; and Approval of the municipal Court Report for June 2016. Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council Member Peterson to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Introduction for RPD Dispatcher: Angela Manzanares – Chief of Police Mike Broadhead introduced Angela Manzanares, the newest member of dispatch, to the Council.

TSA Recognition Award – Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield recognized Rob Heatley for his exceptional performance, while assigned to the Riverton Regional Airport, supporting TSA operations. Mr. Heatley received a certificate from TSA's Supervisory Transportation Security Officer, Masai Rasheed.

Speed Limit Reduction on Airport Road Recommendation – Chief of Police Mike Broadhead reported on a recommendation to reduce the speed limit on Airport Road from 55 mph to 45 mph. Mr. Broadhead met with Wind River Job Corps, Federal Express, Northern Arapaho Business Council and Eastern Shoshone Business Council; all are in support of the speed limit reduction. Member Peterson moved, seconded by Council Member Martinez to approve the speed limit reduction on Airport Road. Motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 16-004, 3rd and Final Reading: Residential Zone Name Change – Finance Director Gloria Hardman read Ordinance No. 16-004 by title only. Ordinance No. 16-004 addresses the proposed name changes for residential areas to change from: Residential A, B, BGA, and C and change to: R-1, R-2, R-A, and R-4. Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council Member Larson for the adoption of Ordinance No. 16-004 on 3rd & Final Reading. A roll call vote was conducted with Council Member (s) Cannan, Martinez, Peterson, Jibben and Mayor John L. Baker voting aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Committee Reports & Council Members' Roundtable – Council Member Jibben reported on the Senior Center Board Meeting she attended; Council Member Peterson congratulated the Little League and Babe Ruth baseball teams as well as the girls softball teams on a successful season; Council Member Martinez commented on the Fremont County School District 25 Recreation Board Meeting he attended; and Council Member Cannan informed the council of Military Night at the Fremont County Fair & Rodeo on August 1, 2016.

City Administrator's Report – City Administrator Steven Weaver thanked the Riverton Rendezvous Committee for all their hard work and encouraged citizens to purchase airline tickets at www.flyriverton.com.

Mayor's Comments – Mayor Baker reported on George Wright retiring from the Airport Board and of an opening on the Wind River Visitors Council. Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council Member Jibben to appoint Jim Gores to the Airport Board and Ryan Preston to the Wind River Visitor's Council. Motion passed unanimously.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Mayor and Council, Council Member Martinez moved, seconded by Council Member Peterson to adjourn the Regular Council Meeting at 7:40 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
