



Riverton City Council Goals 2016

- 1. ATTRACT, CREATE, AND RETAIN A DIVERSE, STABLE AND BUSINESS FRIENDLY ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT THAT SUPPORTS COMMUNITY NEEDS THROUGH GOODS, SERVICES AND JOBS FOR RESIDENTS.**
 - Identify methods of encouraging the success of locally-owned businesses.
 - Continue to work with owners of existing buildings and help facilitate more cost effective remodels and renovations through the use of the International Building Code.
- 2. ENHANCE THE CITY'S IMAGE/APPEARANCE/BEAUTIFICATION**
 - Maintain natural pathways through pavement restoration and lighting.
 - Implement bike and horse patrol on pathways when schedule allows.
 - Increase code enforcement through the use of additional resources (if the budget allows) and focus particularly on entrances to our community.
- 3. SUSTAIN ESSENTIAL AIR SERVICE IN FREMONT COUNTY**
 - Establish a vision and blueprint with F.A.S.T to improve air service reliability and aircraft capacity.
 - Maintain a continuity of commercial air service to Fremont County.
 - Improve countywide support of Riverton Regional Airport through informational and marketing campaigns.
- 4. ADOPT KEY AMENDMENTS TO THE RIVERTON MUNICIPAL CODE**
 - On a consistent basis, continue to identify codes that need to be updated due to conflicts within the RMC or potential unconstitutionality.
 - Streamline the development of zoning codes to enhance business/residential friendly use of the code while maintaining community standards.
 - Promote flexible landscaping requirements in the RMC.
- 5. THROUGH COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS, PROMOTE MORE RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES**
 - Partner with existing recreational facilities (i.e. School District, CWC) by conducting a need based survey of K-12 children.
 - Encourage youth activities with School District and their properties.
 - Encourage the addition of two (2) new statewide events to attract visitors to Riverton.
 - Support efforts of the Splash Pad group to build in City Park in 2017.
- 6. GOOD GOVERNANCE THROUGH FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY**
 - Continue to manage a long-term sustainable budget.
 - Consider potential reduction in revenues through the annual budgeting process.
 - Adhere to sound financial practices by maintaining working capital in the General Fund to support increase/decrease in economic activity.
 - Investigate additional sources of funding for capital improvement projects.
 - Provide factual reports on 1% Sales Tax projects to the community.
