Please throw all other brochures you have received from the City of Riverton away. Our vendors have made changes in what recyclables they will accept. As of November 1, 2012, the attached brochures show the recyclables the City of Riverton will take in the Neighborhood Drop-off areas and at curbside. Some of the changes are Other Plastics (No. 3 through 7, including No. 1 and No. 2 non-bottle plastics). Please watch Channel 11 or check on our website at www.rivertonwy.gov for current information on the Curbside Recycling program. We will also show which recyclable is currently being collected.

Maximum Container (Not Cardboard) Dimensions:
19.75" L x 15.75" W x 13.5" H or 18 gallon capacity

Plastics must be sorted into separate bins as shown above or it will not be picked up. To reduce blowing materials, bins must have lids.



Week 3: ALUMINUM, TIN/STEEL, GLASS


ALUMINUM

Cardboard boxes can be recycled this week. See the Corrugated Cardboard brochure.



Weeks 1, 2, 3: CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, KRAFT PAPER

These are corrugations.



Maximum Container (No Cardboard) Dimensions:
19.75" L x 15.75" W x 13.5" H
or 18 gallon capacity

Cardboard must be broken down and packaging (bubble wrap, foam, etc.) removed or it will not be taken.
