

**RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL**

Minutes of the  
Council Work Session  
Held March 11, 2014  
7:00 PM

A Work Session of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor Ron Warpness at 7:00p.m. City Council Members present were Rich Gard, Martin Cannan, Mary Ellen Christensen, Kyle Larson and Todd Smith. Council Member Christensen led the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Staff present were City Administrator Steven Weaver, City Clerk/Administrative Services Director Courtney V. Bohlender, Chief of Police Mike Broadhead, Community Development Director Sandy Luers, and Customer Service Supervisor Mia Harris.

Council Member Smith moved, seconded by Council Member Christensen to excuse Council Member Faubion from the meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Gard moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the agenda with the addition of Intervening with the State Regarding the EPA Decision before agenda item # 6; and with the addition of Resolution No. 1289 – Support of Riverton Rendezvous Grant Application after agenda item # 7. Motion passed unanimously.

**Intervene with State Regarding EPA Decision** – Council Member Gard moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to intervene in all three lawsuits (State of Wyoming, Devon Energy Corp. and Farm Bureau) against the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Motion passed unanimously.

**EPA Discussion with John Schumacher** – Attorney John Schumacher presented information to the Council regarding Indian Law as it relates to property deeds, sales tax, zoning/building codes, law enforcement jurisdiction, TERO tax and other items of interest.

**Upcoming Agenda Items Discussion** – Mia Harris, Customer Service Supervisor presented the Council with information regarding the park reservation fee system and the potential elimination of the deposit requirement per Council directive. In a separate discussion, Mrs. Bohlender presented the Council with information pursuant to repealing regulations from the Riverton Municipal Code regarding pursuant to business licenses such as Special Investigators, Private Detectives and Security Agents; Taxicabs and Limousine Services; Tree Pruning, Trimming and Removal Businesses.

**Resolution No. 1289 – Support of Riverton Rendezvous Grant Application** – City Clerk/Director of Administrative Services Courtney V. Bohlender read Resolution No. 1289 by title only. Council Member Smith moved, seconded by Council member Christensen to approve Resolution No. 1289. Motion passed unanimously.

**Adjourn** - There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Gard moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to adjourn the meeting at 8:22 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
