

RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL

Minutes of the
Regular Council Meeting
Held May 20, 2014
7:00 PM

The regular meeting of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor Ronald O. Warpness at 7:00 p.m. City Council Members present were Rich Gard, Martin Cannan, Mary Ellen Christensen, Jonathan Faubion, Kyle Larson, and Todd Smith. Council Member Faubion led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Warpness declared a quorum of the Council.

City Staff present were City Administrator Steven M. Weaver, City Clerk/Director of Administrative Services Courtney V. Bohlender, Chief of Police Mike Broadhead, Interim Public Services Director Dawn Willhelm, and Community Development Director Sandy Luers.

Approval of the Agenda – Council Member Faubion moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the agenda with the addition of Tree Board appointment to agenda item number 13. Motion passed unanimously.

Communication from the Floor – A presentation on a multi-use facility was presented by Riverton High School Students. Another presentation on a recreation center was presented by Riverton High School Leadership Students.

Consent Agenda – City Clerk/Director of Administrative Services Courtney V. Bohlender read the consent agenda items by title only: Approval of the Minutes – May 6, 2014 Regular Council Meeting; Approval of the Minutes – May 13, 2014 Council Work Session; Approval of the Minutes – May 19, 2014 Finance Committee Meeting; Approval of the Finance Committee Recommendations – May 19, 2014; Approval of the Municipal Court Report for the month of April, 2014; Finance Committee recommended approval of the bills to be paid in the amount of \$673,746.42, manual checks in the amount of \$750.00, Elan credit card in the amount of \$5,373.97, checks written for payroll/liabilities for 5/1/14 in the amount of \$508,622.41, for a total of \$1,188,492.80. Council Member Gard moved, seconded by Council Member Christensen to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Retirement Recognition for Clyde Anderson – Community Development Director Sandy Luers presented Clyde Anderson with an engraved pocket watch, thanking him for his years of service.

Replat of Buffalo Subdivision – Council Member Faubion moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the replat without modification. After some discussion from members of the public, motion passed unanimously.

Replat of Block 1, Ryan Heights Addition Replat No. 2 – Council Member Smith moved, seconded by Council Member Gard to approve the replat of Block 1, Ryan Heights Addition Replat No. 2. Motion passed unanimously.

North Federal Utilities Project Design Consultant Recommendation – Council Member Gard moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with HDR for the North Federal Utilities Design Consultant. After some discussion, motion passed unanimously.

FORCC Committee Recommendation – Purchase of DuraPatcher – After some discussion from Council, Staff and FORCC Committee Chairman, Council Member Gard moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to table this item. Motion passed unanimously.

Board Appointment – Planning Commission & Tree Board – Council Member Faubion moved, seconded by Council Member Gard to approve the reappointment of the two Planning Commission Members; and the appointment of Aaron Justice to the Tree Board for a four (4) year term. Motion passed unanimously.

Sanitation Services – After discussion from Council and Staff, Council Member Smith moved, seconded by Council Member Faubion to go to a four (4) day a week sanitation operation schedule. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Committee Reports & Council Members' Roundtable – Council Members Gard, Faubion, reported on the Arbor Day Celebration, PAWS Animal Shelter garage sale and Redneck BBQ, respectively.

City Administrator's Report – City Administrator Steven Weaver announced that the Fremont County Solid Waste will be having a free e-waste disposal day on June 7, 2014. Budget Work Session will be held on May 27, 2014, at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor's Comments – Mayor Warpness reported on the awards banquet for Cody Myers. Mayor Warpness also reported on the Fremont County Consensus Fund meeting that he and Mr. Weaver attended.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Gard moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to adjourn the Regular Council Meeting at 8:33 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
