

RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL

Minutes of the
Council Work Session
Held July 9, 2013
7:00 PM

A Work Session of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor Pro-tem Rich Gard at 7:00p.m. Mayor Ron Warpness was absent. City Council Members present were Mary Ellen Christensen, Todd Smith, John ‘Lars’ Baker, and Eric Heiser. Council Member Christensen led the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Staff present were Police Chief Mike Broadhead (Acting City Administrator), City Clerk/Administrative Services Director Courtney V. Bohlender and Community Development Director Sandy Luers.

Council Member Heiser moved, seconded by Council Member Smith to excuse Jonathan Faubion, John “Lars” Baker (Council Member Baker arrived at 7:07p.m.) and Mayor Ron Warpness. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Smith moved, seconded by Council Member Christensen to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Administrative Services Director Courtney V. Bohlender reported to the Council that the date for Open Container Permit application submitted by Injury Prevention Resources for a Simulated Intox Event (Educational Wetlab) has been changed from August 2, 2013 to August 9, 2013 (both dates were on the application).

Graduation Matters Riverton Campaign – John Griffith, Principal of the Riverton High School, presented information on the objectives for this campaign. The objectives are: increase the rate of students graduating from Riverton High School, College and Career ready; establish a support network between schools, businesses and community organizations for student success; and create school-based and community-based opportunities for student success.

Substance Abuse and Crime in Riverton - Ernest Johnson, Owner and Director of Services for Johnson and Associates, presented statistical information and trends analysis of alcohol and crime in Wyoming due to DUI’s, Public Intoxication, Traffic crashes, BAC’s (Blood Alcohol Content) and use of drugs.
