

**ENROLLED ORDINANCE NO. 18-004**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 16 “SUBDIVISIONS” TO REVISE CHAPTER 16.16 “DESIGN STANDARDS”, SECTION 16.16.050 “SIDEWALKS” OF THE RIVERTON MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIVERTON, FREMONT COUNTY, WYOMING:**

**Section 1.** Section 16.16.050 of the Municipal Code for the City of Riverton, Wyoming is hereby amended to read as follows:

**16.16.050 Sidewalks**

~~—A. All sidewalks shall be a minimum width of three and one-half feet and may be of an attached design.~~

~~—B. In commercial and industrial areas adjacent to arterial streets, sidewalks shall be five feet in width and of a detached design.~~

~~—C. In addition, all sidewalks shall be ramped at all street intersections or other pedestrian crossing areas. (Prior code § 24-23)~~

*All curb ramp, ramp, and sidewalk located within and subject to the jurisdiction of the city shall comply with the minimum guidelines for design set forth in the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG), July 26, 1991, and any successor editions. The city shall utilize ADAAG in setting appropriate design requirements.*

**Section 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect from its adoption and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Riverton.
