

ENROLLED ORDINANCE NO. 18-010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10 “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” TO REVISE CHAPTER 10.28 “ABANDONED VEHICLES”, SECTION 10.28.020 “KEEPING OR PARKING OF VEHICLES PROHIBITED WHEN.” OF THE RIVERTON MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIVERTON, FREMONT COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1. Section 10.28.020 of the Municipal Code for the City of Riverton, Wyoming is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.28.020 Keeping or parking of vehicles prohibited when.

A person shall not keep, store, park, maintain or otherwise permit an inoperable or unlicensed vehicle, in an area zoned ~~Residence A~~ Residential 1 (R-1), ~~Residence B~~ Residential 2 (R-2), ~~Residence BGA~~ Residential 2A (R-2A), Residential 3 (R-3), ~~Residence C~~ Residential 4 (R-4), or Residential PUD, unless screened from ordinary view. Inoperative vehicles in noncompliance with the provision hereof shall be removed within ~~thirty (30) days from the effective date of the ordinance codified in this section~~ and thereafter within five (5) days of notice to any owner, tenant or lessee of the premises. (Prior code § 13-9.5 (part))

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from its adoption and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Riverton.
