

RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL
Minutes of the
Special Council Meeting
Held July 9, 2019
6:00 PM

The special meeting of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor Richard P. Gard at 6:00 p.m. City Council Members present were Karla Borders, Tim Hancock, Mike Bailey, Rebecca Schatza, Kyle Larson, and Cory Rota. Council Member Hancock led the pledge of allegiance and Council Member Larson conducted the invocation.

Roll call was conducted. Mayor Gard declared a quorum of the Council.

City Staff present: City Administrator Tony Tolstedt, City Clerk/Human Resource Director Kristin Watson, Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield, Chief of Police Eric Murphy, Finance Director Mia Harris, Community Development Director Eric P. Carr, and Deputy City Clerk/Administrative Assistant Megan Sims.

Approval of the Agenda – Council Member Schatza moved, seconded by Council Member Hancock to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Resolution No. 1395 – Supporting Abandoned Mine Lands (AML) Public Facility Grant Applications – Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield presented Resolution No. 1395 for the submittal of two Abandoned Mine Lands (AML) Public Facility Grant applications to the State Loan and Investment Board. City Clerk/Human Resource Director Kristin Watson read Resolution No. 1395 by title only. Council Member Hancock moved, seconded by Council Member Bailey to approve Resolution No. 1395. Council Member Bailey moved, seconded by Council Member Borders to amend the motion to increase the amount of funds requested as staff sees fit. Amended motion passed unanimously. Main motion also passed unanimously.

Convene into Work Session – Council Member Hancock moved, seconded by Council Member Rota to convene into the Work Session Meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Fiscal Year 2019 – 2020 Goal Setting Session – City Administrator Tony Tolstedt led discussion with the Council by reviewing FY2019 goals and accomplishments. Mr. Tolstedt and the Council further discussed goals submitted by staff for FY2020, ranking them by priority and then discussed the objectives to help accomplish these goals. Mr. Tolstedt will draft the goals into a formal document to be adopted by resolution at a regular meeting of the City Council. No action was taken.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Borders moved, seconded by Council Member Rota to adjourn the Work Session Council meeting at 8:50 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
