

RIVERTON CITY COUNCIL
Minutes of the
Work Session Meeting
Held September 8, 2020
7:00 PM

The work session meeting of the Riverton City Council was held on the above date and time, duly convened by Mayor Richard P. Gard at 7:00 p.m. City Council Members present were Karla Borders, Tim Hancock, Mike Bailey, Rebecca Schatza, Kyle Larson, and Cory Rota. Council Member Larson led the pledge of allegiance and Council Member Hancock conducted the invocation.

Roll call was conducted. Mayor Gard declared a quorum of the Council.

City Staff present: City Administrator Tony Tolstedt, City Clerk/Human Resource Director Kristin Watson, Public Works Director Kyle Butterfield, Police Chief Eric Murphy, Finance Director Mia Harris, and Community Development Director Eric P. Carr.

Approval of the Agenda – Council Member Schatza moved, seconded by Council Member Rota to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Riverton Municipal Code 8.04: Fireworks Discussion – City Administrator Tony Tolstedt led the Council in a discussion regarding RMC Chapter 8.04, specifically the changes that were adopted by ordinance in February 2019 that revised the code to allow for fireworks in City limits from 5:00 PM on December 31st to 12:30 AM on January 1st; and from 6:00 PM to 11:45 PM on July 4th; unless otherwise restricted by the City Council via resolution. Council Members all shared their thoughts on the future allowance of fireworks in City limits. Mayor Gard thanked the members of the public, council and staff for their opinions on the subject. No action was taken.

City of Riverton Logo Concept Review & Discussion – City Administrator Tony Tolstedt presented the City of Riverton logo concepts that were created by Herrmann Global. It was the consensus of the Council for staff to present a recommendation for approval of a new logo for a uniform branding approach at the next Regular Council Meeting. No action was taken.

Adjourn – There being no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Gard adjourned the work session meeting at 8:19 p.m. There was no objection from the Council.
